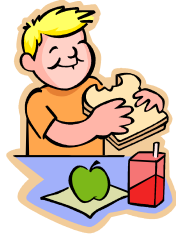
Dubyak Family for a great event. Keep an eye out for the pumpkin pie contest coming this fall just before Thanksgiving.

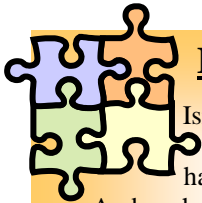

For car donations (and boats, ect..) the value of the deduction is limited to what the charity sells it for (not the fair market value of the item.)
