Our Modesto Site is located at St. Stanislaus Catholic School at 1416 Maze Blvd. St. Stanislaus Catholic Parish has graciously allowed United Samaritans Foundation the use of the kitchen in their community center at the school since July 1998. Our staff at this site is Glenda and Lizette. Glenda has been with USF for eleven years and Lizette for four years. They work hard to prepare nutritious meals at the site and then they deliver the lunches on our mobile food truck to seven stops

in the south west area of Modesto, Monday thru Friday. In 2009, with the help of volunteers, 114,172 lunches were prepared and then served from the mobile food truck to the hungry in the community. 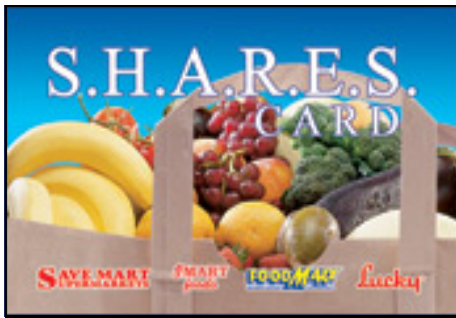

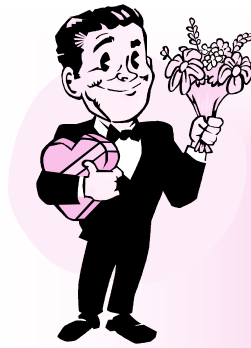
