ANNUAL POST OFFICE FOOD DRIVE MAY 8TH



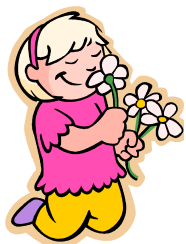

USF HIGHLIGHTS THE TURLOCK SITE



The Turlock site is home to our administrative staff: Director, Barbara, Operations Manager, Maris, Accountant, Holly, Administrative Assistant, Toni and our Receptionist, Paz. Eight hundred meals a day are prepared in our kitchen for the Turlock and Keyes/Ceres mobile lunch truck routes by staff persons Cheryl and Falesoa, assisted by community service workers and many volunteers. Anita serves the homeless that use

the Homeless drop-in Center for showers and laundry. Through the Emergency Box Program over two hundred Turlock residents who are in need of more than just a daily lunch are assisted. We thank the dedicated group of volunteers and community service workers who help prepare and distribute the food boxes on the last Tuesday and Friday of each month. Staff person, Betty assists clients in the Clothes Closet with help from volunteers and community service workers who sort the clothes that are donated for the Clothes Closet. In our warehouse, Russel keeps our trucks running, while Bill and Ronnie are busy picking up food product that has been donated from local businesses. We thank the volunteers who also help with this task. We deeply appreciate all our hardworking staff and our many volunteers who help us carry out our mission. We couldn't do it without them.
