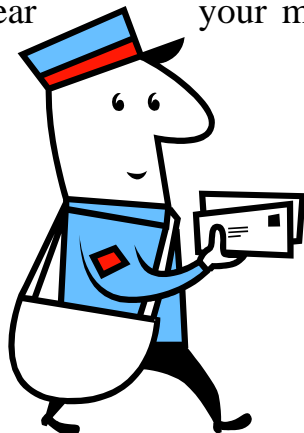

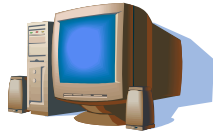


LUNCHESES SERVED
