Through our referral services, Robert was made aware of the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program and is now housed. 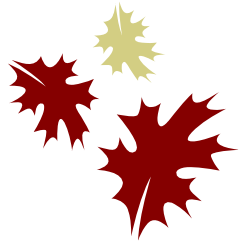
Daily Bread Lunch Program: 35,848 Lunches Served

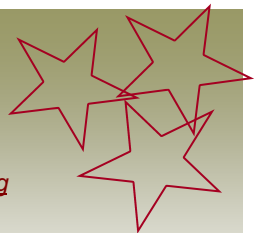
